Rules and Regulations

NO plants or blooms may be removed from the show hall before 4 PM on Sunday. Unclaimed plants or flowers will be disposed of at the discretion of the Show Committee. Reasonable care will be taken but TVOS assumes no liability for loss or damage of plants or exhibits.

EXHIBITION RULES:

1. Open Show. Anyone may exhibit in accordance with the show schedule and rules. Placing an entry is an agreement to abide by these rules. Both blooming plants and cut flowers may be entered.
2. Exhibit space must be reserved in advance.
3. Exhibitors must complete an entry tag for each plant/cut flower or floral display/arrangement.
4. Orchid societies or individuals may combine entries in a single display.
5. Entries must be received between 4 pm and 7 pm on Friday or by prior arrangement with the Show Chairperson. Setup must be completed prior to Judging on Saturday.
6. No plant may be entered in more than one class.
7. Plants **must** be clean, well-groomed and watered before being displayed. Entry of diseased or infected plants will be refused and removed from hall.
8. No plant or bloom may be removed before 4PM on Sunday.
9. TVOS will use reasonable precautions in the care of exhibits but cannot assume liability for loss or damage of plants or exhibits.

AWARDS AND TROPHIES:

1. First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded in all class/divisions.

RIBBON JUDGING WITH THE AMERICAN ORCHID SOCIETY

Ribbon Judging will be in accordance with the standard rules as published in the *Handbook on Judging and Exhibition*, latest edition. Only judges and their clerks will be permitted in the show area while judging is in progress.

The following rules apply:

1. Judging begins at 8:00 AM on Saturday.
2. At the Judges discretion, they may:
 - a. Disqualify or re-classify plants,
 - b. Subdivide or add any class as needed,
 - c. Award duplicate ribbons within any classification,
 - d. Withhold any ribbon or trophy.
3. Decisions of Judges and Chairperson shall be final.
4. All orchids and blooms entered will be considered for AOS judging and TVOS ribbons.
5. In awarding trophies or ribbons for the best individual plants, the word “best” refers to the quality of the bloom.

PLANT ENTRY CLASSES:

Class numbers must correspond to the classes listed in this booklet. Plants and blooms will be considered for judging only if entered in the correct class. TVOS will provide electronic entry tags. Advance plant or flower or floral display registration is **preferred** and entry information may be sent to Ruth Mayer at ruthmayer@cablone.net. Please return all unused tags to the clerks.

PLANT SALES

It is by invitation only to sell at this show. You must be a member of the Treasure Valley Orchid Society or an exhibitor in the current show. All sales will be handled by the Treasure Valley Orchid Society. Sale space is limited; therefore, sale table allotments may be relative to a vendor's exhibit area. Sellers are responsible for staffing their sales area.

Each plant offered for sale must contain two tags:

Tag 1: Name of plant which will remain with the plant after the sale.

Tag 2: Price of plant and seller's name or identification for TVOS accounting.

All show transactions must pass through the TVOS cash register. Sellers will be paid by check within ten days after the close of the show. Amount of check will reflect 20% retained by the Treasure Valley Orchid Society which reserves the right to collect on all plant and merchandise sales made on the premises of the show from either sale area or exhibits. Plants sold from exhibit tables may not be removed until 4:00pm on Sunday, March 6th, and must be sold through the TVOS cash register.

Plants must be free from disease and insect. Each plant must have been repotted properly with roots secured and established, or bare root. At the discretion of the Show and /or Sale Chairman and member(s) of the TVOS Board of directors, a vendor may be asked to remove diseased or un-established plants from their sale table. Our success depends on the success of buyers who bring repeat sales to future shows.
